

ADVOCATING FOR CLIENT RIGHTS AND NEEDS

Key Nurse Responsibilities:

- Promoting autonomy and safeguarding interests
- Supporting patients in navigating healthcare systems





UNDERSTANDING PATIENT RIGHTS

Privacy & Confidentiality	HIPAA compliance and secure information handling
Informed Consent	Comprehensive communication on treatment options
Autonomy	Respect for patient decisions, including refusal of treatment
Safe and Respectful Care	Protection from abuse and culturally competent care



EMPOWERING PATIENTS

Patient-Centered Care:

Respect preferences and involve in decisionmaking

Health Literacy:

Use clear communication and teaching aids

Self-Management:

Educate on chronic condition care and when to seek help

Support for Vulnerable Groups:

Advocate for elderly, children, and disabled individuals



NAVIGATING ADVOCACY BARRIERS

Common Barriers:

Cultural differences and language limitations

Time constraints and institutional policies

Moral distress and personal biases

Solutions:

Professional interpreters

Time management and peer support

Ethics committees and cultural competence training

Definition:


Transferring responsibility for tasks while retaining accountability




